These events will be open to Surf Life Saving Club member/s from any affiliated club with SLSA or the ILS. These events will also be open to any non member to enter as per the entry details listed further in this circular and on the SLSQ website – www.lifesaving.com.au

They will be –

Saturday 31st July 2010 – “COOLY OCEAN CLASSIC”

Starting and finishing at **Coolangatta SLSC** on the Coolangatta Beach.

Saturday 28th August 2010 – “NOOSA OCEAN CLASSIC”

Starting and finishing at **Noosa Heads SLSC** on Main Beach, Noosa Heads.

Saturday 11th September 2010 – EMU PARK OCEAN CLASSIC”

Starting and finishing at **Emu Park SLSC** on Emu Park Beach, east of Rockhampton

Sunday 19th September 2010 – “PICNIC BAY OCEAN CLASSIC”

Starting and finishing at **Picnic Bay SLSC** on The Strand, Townsville

Non SLSA members - \$25.00 per person
